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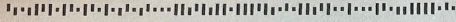

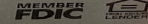

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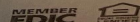

### Event Report

On April 1, 2023, New Orleans Area of Narcotics Anonymous along with the Unity Area of Narcotics Anonymous held a joint venture Easter Egg Hunt at City Park from 1 pm – 5 pm. Area participation was good, and members attended with their husbands, wives, children, and grandchildren. The main speaker for the event was Paul P. who shared his experience, strength, and hope on recovery in both areas. Our common welfare should come first personal responsibility depends on NA unity. Unity was exactly what was achieved in this first area joint venture. The Easter Egg Hunt was a joy to watch as the children rushed around looking for the plastic easter eggs that were donated by grateful recovering addicts from both areas. A total of 500 easter eggs were collected and some eggs were filled with golden surprises. Due to some issues that popped up last minute the areas were not able to fulfill the inflatable bounce house plan because power was needed to blow up the bounce houses. Without a paid shelter, there was not a way to blow up the bounce house to utilize and City Park prohibits the use of generators in the park. So instead, the area bought games, activities, balloons, and other entertainment for the children. The weather was great, and the event went well. Moving forward

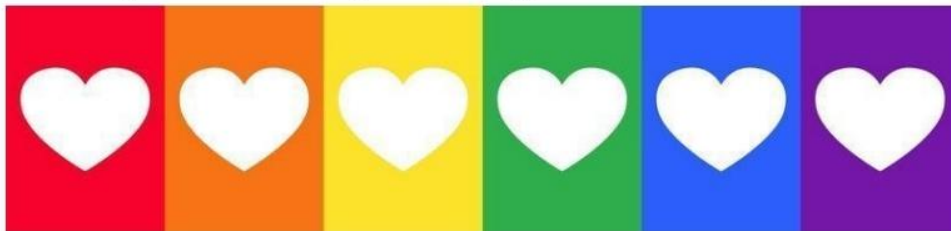

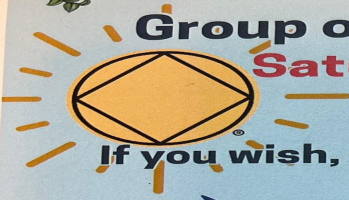
